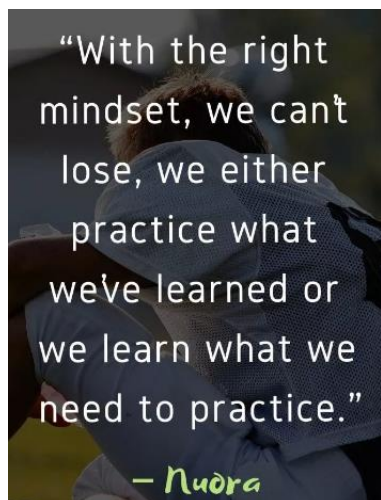

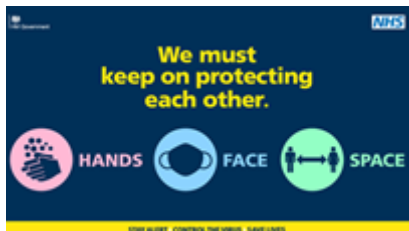
Free School Meals

COVID Updates

How you can help keep everyone at Northwold Safe



- ✓ Keep 2m apart when dropping off and collecting children.
- ✓ Only one adult should enter the site to collect their child or children
- ✓ Use the one way system in place in the school.
- ✓ Wear a mask while you are on site (if you are unable to because of medical reasons, please maintain 2m distancing when communicating with staff).

- ✓ Contact the school immediately if someone in your household becomes unwell with COVID symptoms.

Please ensure that you contact 111 if your child or anyone in your household has any of the following symptoms:

- **A high temperature:** any new high temperature where your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to measure the temperature)
- **A new continuous cough:** coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- **A loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste:** a noticeable loss of smell or taste or things smell and taste different to normal.

For most people, COVID-19 will be a mild illness. However, if you have any of the above symptoms please stay at home and arrange to have a test.

Please ensure that you complete the following:

- Do not send your child to school if they display any of the above symptoms. You will need to book a test and isolate until you receive the test results.
- Contact the school to inform us of the symptoms.
- If your child has taken a COVID 19 test, they should not return to school until you have received the test result. Please inform the school if your child has taken a test and again once you have the results.
