This week was Enterprise week. Each class designed and created a product. They had to pitch to the Dragon's Den panel to gain an investment in their product. The children had to complete a market research, create an advert for their product, calculate the cost and selling price of their product and calculate the profit they would make if they sold a particular number of items. Due to COVID restrictions we are unable to set up stalls in the playground and sell the items to parents. We are therefore asking parents to make a voluntary contribution to your child's class for the item that they have produced. The children will be given the item to take home.

### COVID Updates

#### How you can help keep everyone at Northwold Safe



- ✓ Keep 2m apart when dropping off and collecting children.
- ✓ Only one adult should enter the site to collect their child or children
- ✓ Use the one way system in place in the school.
- ✓ Wear a mask while you are on site (if you are unable to because of medical reasons, please maintain 2m distancing when communicating with staff).
- ✓ Contact the school immediately if someone in your household becomes unwell with COVID symptoms.

Please ensure that you contact 111 if your child or anyone in your household has any of the following symptoms:

- **A high temperature:** any new high temperature where your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to measure the temperature)
- **A new continuous cough:** coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- **A loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste:** a noticeable loss of smell or taste or things smell and taste different to normal.

For most people, COVID-19 will be a mild illness.

However, if you have any of the above symptoms please stay at home and arrange to have a test.

**Please ensure that you complete the following:**

- **Do not send your child to school if they display any of the above symptoms. You will need to book a test and isolate until you receive the test results.**
- **Contact the school to inform us of the symptoms.**
- **If your child has taken a COVID 19 test, they should not return to school until you receive the test result. Please inform the school that your child has taken a test and again once you have the results.**
