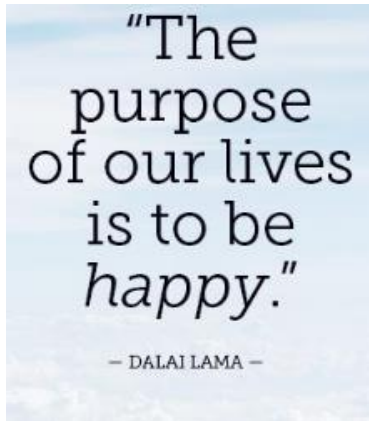

#### Information on school attendance expectation
