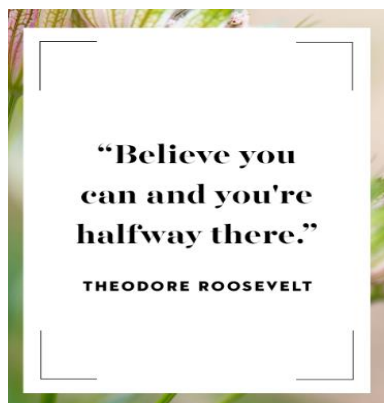

Dear Parents/ Carers,

This term we have been working on resources used to deliver the curriculum. Over the past three weeks we have had year group parent meetings to share the curriculum for the academic year. Our curriculum is a progression model; it is sequenced to ensure cumulative layers of knowledge.

We use retrieval, recall, recap and rehearsal as strategies to ensure that children remember what they learn. The effective use of resources will help children to build on their learning and understanding and help them to learn more and remember more.

Your child will be given weekly homework whether in books or online. All online login details were sent home this week with your child. Please ensure that they complete their homework. Reading books will go home every week too. It is extremely important that you hear your children read on a daily basis and write a comment in their reading records. Teachers will contribute to these records when they read with your children in class.
